## PASS Practice Tests Tests with Instructional Feedback for Grades 3–12



PASS practice tests are designed to help Louisiana students prepare for the LEAP, GEE, iLEAP, LAA2, and high school End-of-Course tests. PASS includes tests in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies.

- Students have an opportunity to become familiar with test questions similar to those on statewide assessments.
- Multiple-choice, short-answer, and extended-response questions and writing prompts are included.
- Detailed instructional feedback for multiple-choice and short-answer questions is provided immediately.
- Student reports can be used by students and teachers to track progress.
- Read-aloud (audio) function is available for some tests in grades 4, 8, and high school.
- Parents and teachers can log in and use the parent/teacher resources.

Students needing practice with mathematics skills can go to Newton's Classroom. A pre-test helps determine the appropriate tutorial level for a student to begin.
