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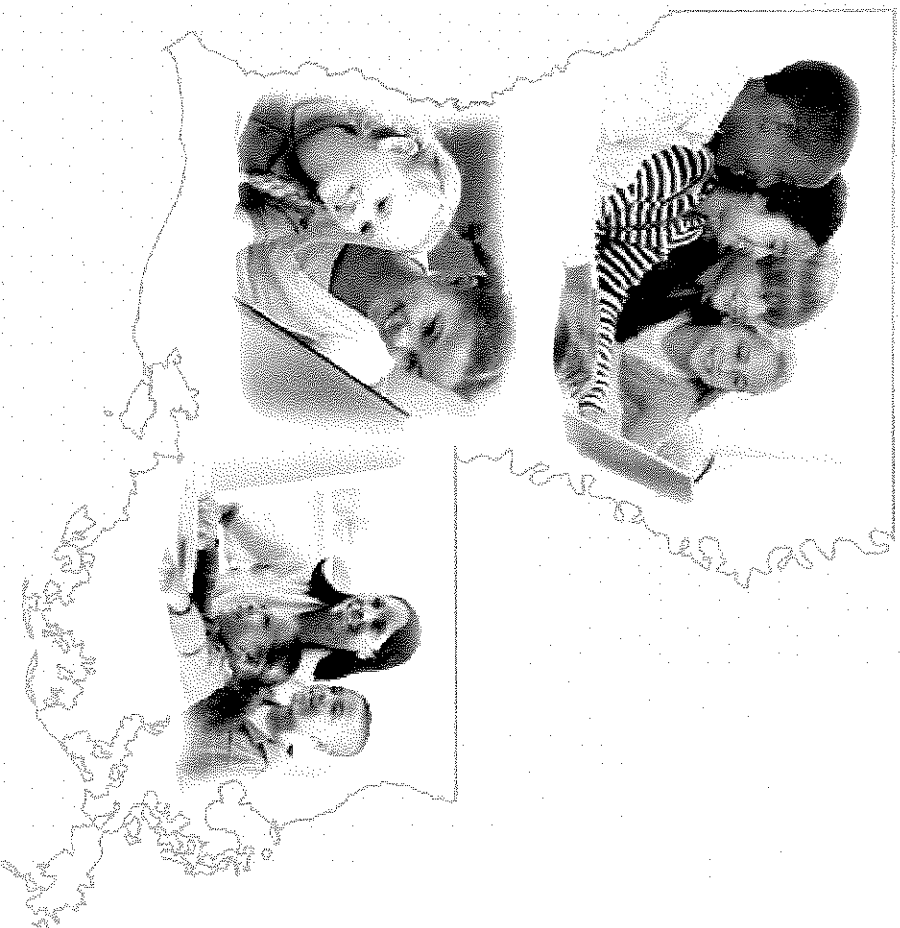

PASS Practice Tests

Tests with Instructional Feedback for Grades 3–12



PASS practice tests are designed to help Louisiana students prepare for the LEAP, GEE, iLEAP, LAA2, and high school End-of-Course tests. PASS includes tests in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies.

- Students have an opportunity to become familiar with test questions similar to those on statewide assessments.
- Multiple-choice, short-answer, and extended-response questions and writing prompts are included.
- Detailed instructional feedback for multiple-choice and short-answer questions is provided immediately.
- Student reports can be used by students and teachers to track progress.
- Read-aloud (audio) function is available for some tests in grades 4, 8, and high school.
- Parents and teachers can log in and use the parent/teacher resources.

Newton's Classroom

Mathematics Tutorials for Grades 1–8



Students needing practice with mathematics skills can go to Newton's Classroom. A pre-test helps determine the appropriate tutorial level for a student to begin. A quiz at the end of each level helps students check their understanding and provides instructional feedback.

The Reading Runway

Reading Tutorials for Grades PreK–3



This resource is designed to help young students develop the skills to become lifelong readers. The program promotes the development of phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary/oral language, and comprehension. Audio is required for this program.

- Students choose interactive lessons that best meet their reading needs.
- During the activities, students are introduced to characters in the different settings. These characters act as guides to assist students as they learn the skills in each activity.
- Activity reports are provided to track student progress.
